How many letters are in the alphabet?
There are 26 letters in the alphabet.
What are the two SIZES of letters?
The two sizes of letters are uppercase and lowercase.
What do we call uppercase letters?
We call uppercase letters capital letters.
What are the two TYPES of letters?
The two types of letters are consonants and vowels.
How many vowels are there?
There are five vowels: a, e, I, o, u.
What letter is sometimes a vowel?
Y is sometimes a vowel.
What are the SHORT sounds of the vowels?
The short sounds are /a/ /e/ /i/ /o/ /u/. (parent clues: apple, elbow, inch, on, up)
What are the LONG vowel sounds?
The long vowel sounds are A, E, I, O, U. (their names)

What is the capital of the United States of America?

The capital of the United States is Washington D.C.

How many states are there in the United States?

There are 50 states in the United States of America.

In which state do you live?

I live in the state of Florida.

In which city do you live?

I live in (Palm Bay, Melbourne).

On what planet do we live?

We live on planet earth.

How many planets are in our Solar System?

There are 8 planets and Pluto, a "dwarf planet."

Name all 9 planets in order from the Sun.

Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune.

What is the Sun?

The Sun is a star.
